Adriana, a native of Caracas, Venezuela, shared her story of immigration to the United States.

It began in 2000, when she met her future husband, a native of Colombia with permanent residence in the U.S.

Adriana came to the US in 2003 on a student visa to study at Wichita State University. She completed her degree, married and had a baby daughter. Because her student visa was expiring, she had to return to Caracas with her six-month-old daughter. Fortunately, within nine months she was able to secure an employer sponsorship and return to Wichita.

In 2014, with five years of permanent residency, she was able to apply for citizenship, completing an eleven-year process to become a U.S. citizen. Although it was not easy, she is happy to be living and working in the U.S. with her family.
